Latvian-Estonian Intergovernmental Commission for Cross- border Cooperation


- Established in 2004 by Intergovernmental Agreement
- Coordinated by Estonian Ministry of Interior and Latvian Ministry of Environmental Protection and Regional Development
- Joint meeting once a year + thematic Working Groups
- Focuses on EE-LV border regions
- Elaborates Annual Work Plan and facilitates dialogue on national, regional, local level (amendments in national legislation, cooperation agreements)



When TWO aspire to become ONE: Valka and Valga



- Joint development strategy since 2005
- Joint Labor bourse since 2014
- Common management of cross-border river
- Separate management of joint infrastructure/facilities
- Functional reintegration of common urban space
- Ambitious plans:
 - Common ice-hall,
 - Common business incubator
